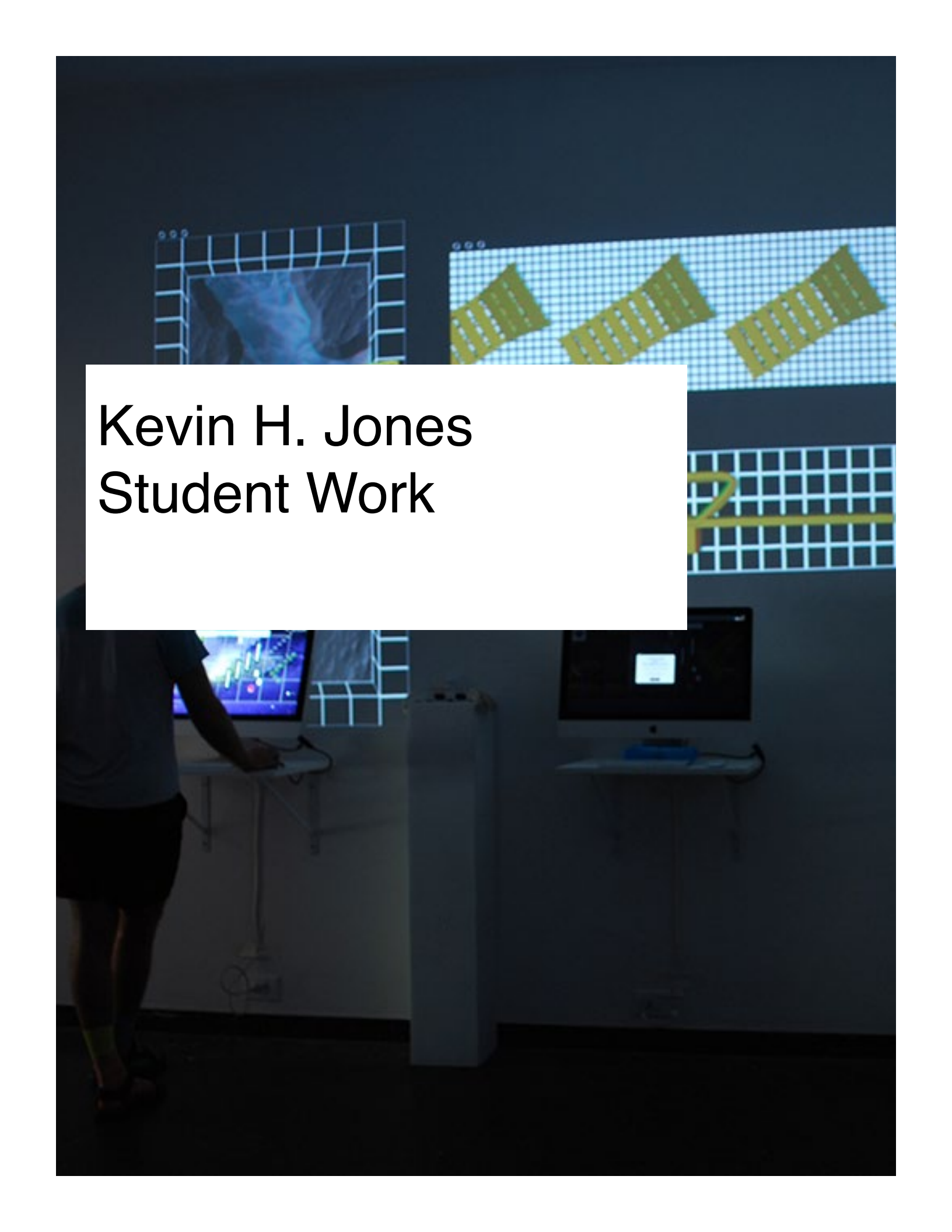

- We will be working in both Photoshop and Illustrator.



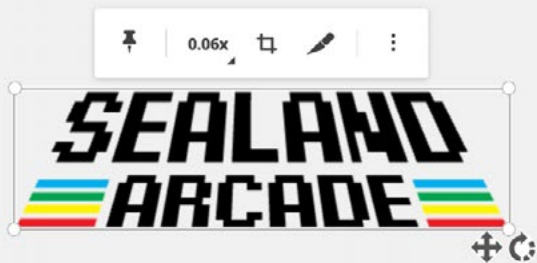

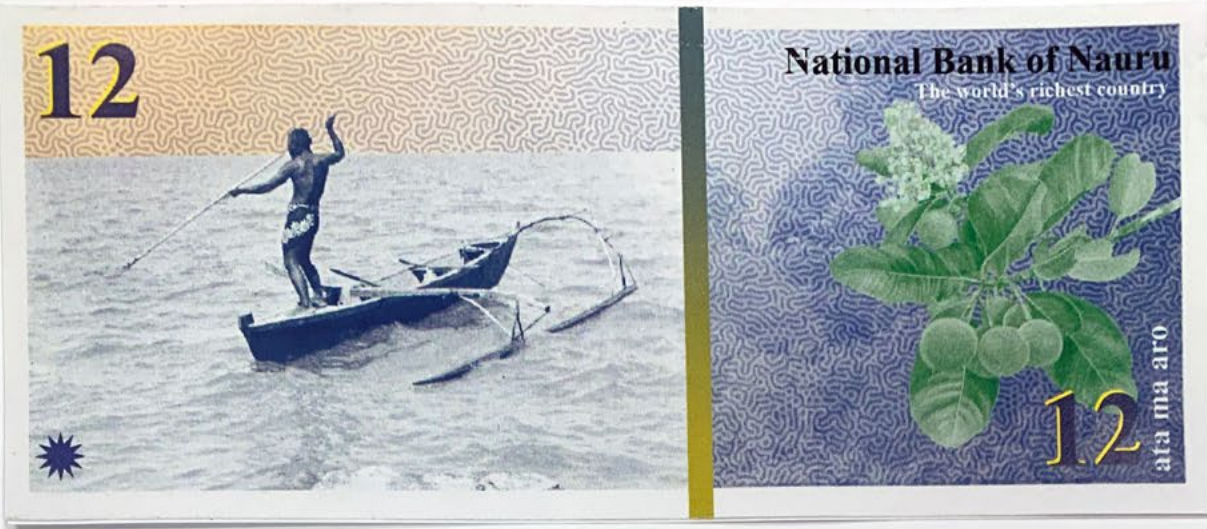
With this project you will be creating a monetary system for The Republic of Nauru. You can base this monetary system upon its history, geography, politics, Religion, environment etc.

Currency name, Denomination 5 10 15 20 ?, Format, Scale, Color Graphics, Anti-counterfeit etc.

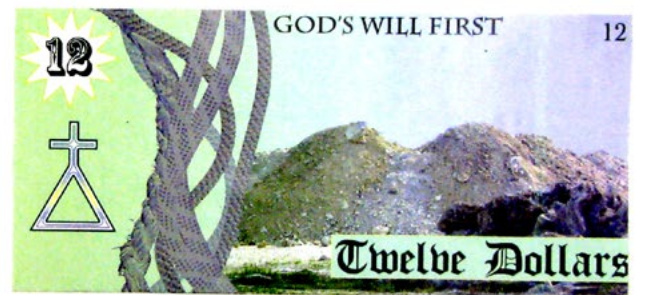
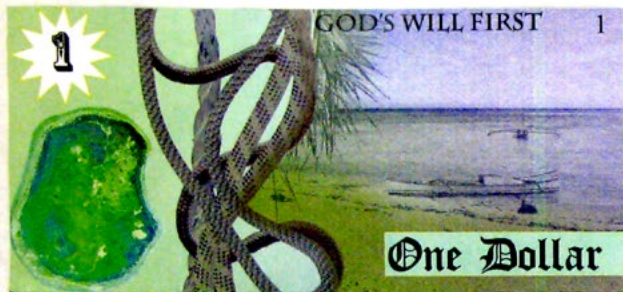
